

## The drawings you give us...

Drawings come in all shapes and sizes. We care more about detailed specifications than pretty drawings (although we do love pretty drawings). The more information your drawings can provide, the more accurate our estimates will be. We will be producing in-house engineered shop drawings for your approval before your cabinets move into production. Those "Shop Drawings" will include all of your specifications in addition to certain fabrication details for our cabinet makers.

Please include as much of the following information as you can:

1. Dimensions or scaled drawings of all areas receiving cabinets (by hand, or by computer)
2. Cabinet species and finish for all areas ("cherry cabinets with a natural finish," "stained oak")
3. Door style (flat panel, raised panel or slab)
4. A general note on any specific cabinet hardware or special features you want included
5. Appliance specifications if you have them.
6. A note on unusual site conditions ("walls not plumb," "restricted access," "crane needed for install")
7. Drawer box construction (solid wood, plywood or particle board)

You need not know everything about your cabinets before requesting an estimate from us. Just do your best to get us as much as possible under the circumstances.
